

COVID-19 NEWS UPDATE

2nd Extension of stay-at-home orders from 19 - 30 July

Dear Parents and Carers

With the NSW Government's latest announcement that the stay-at-home orders will be extended to 30 July 2021, please read below for the 2 options available to you regarding your child's place at Tanderra throughout this lockdown period:

Option 1.

Families who will not be using Tanderra between Monday 19 – Friday 30 July

- Your child's place will be put on hold for the duration of the lockdown. He/she will be able to resume their place at the end of the lockdown period.
- You will *not* have to pay the gap fee during this period.
- All absence requirements will continue as usual. All children were replenished with 42 absences from 1 July.

What do I need to do in relation to this latest information?

- You don't need to do anything re your waived gap fee. We will manage all arrangements and ensure that your account is not charged for fees accrued during this period.
- Please notify us via email that your child will not be attending the centre and that you would like their place to be kept open for the duration.

Option 2.

Families who will be using Tanderra during the lockdown period

- Your child can continue to attend on the usual days expected.
- Fees will be payable as usual for all permanent and casual days booked.
- Feel free to book any extra sessions of care you may wish your child to attend.

What do I need to do in relation to this information?

- Nothing. We will expect all children to attend the centre as usual unless we are notified otherwise by you.
